
Your KoolVend vending machine comes equipped with a Nayax Credit Card Reader, providing a convenient way to accept card payments.



- **5. Start Accepting Card Payments:** With the credit card reader set up, you can begin accepting credit card payments through your KoolMore vending machine.





VENDING MACHINE USE PREPARATION AND PLACEMENT ENVIRONMENT


- 1. Upon receiving the machine, carefully inspect the packaging for any signs of damage. If any damage is found, please contact the logistics provider and our company directly for assistance.
- 2. Before using the machine, remove all packaging components such as wood boards, protective films, foam, and cable tie.
- 3. Choose an appropriate location for placing the machine, considering the following factors:
 - The placement area should be dry, well-ventilated, and away from sources of heat.
 - Ensure the machine is protected from rain or water splashes.
 - Avoid placing the machine in areas with low temperatures that may affect its operation.
 - Select a solid and stable ground surface for proper support.
 - Leave a clearance of at least 7.8 inch from the wall for ventilation.
- 4. After placing the machine, allow it to stand for a minimum of 30 minutes before powering it on. This ensures the machine's stability and proper operation. If cooling functionality is required, allow the machine to stand for 4-5 hours before turning on the cooling feature to prevent any adverse effects on the compressor. The machine has a normal power consumption of 60W, a maximum cooling power of 510W, and a maximum heating power of 760W. Cooling and heating functions are optional features.


Note: Adhering to the above guidelines for preparation and placement environment will help ensure the optimal performance and longevity of the vending machine.
















⚠ WARNING

The power supply of the vending machine must be grounded! An ungrounded machine must not be used, as it poses serious security risks. Ensure proper grounding before use!

VENDING MACHINE SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Use a reliable AC 220V/50Hz/10A power supply. Voltage fluctuations outside the range of 200-240V may cause machine failure.



Utilize a reliable three-hole socket with grounding. Failure to do so could result in the risk of electric shock. After the machine is installed, ensure the plug is easily accessible.








Protect the power cord:


- A. Always hold the plug tightly (do not pull the power cord directly); pull out directly from the socket.
- B. Ensure the machine does not press on the power cord, and do not step on the power cord manually.
- C. Be careful not to crush or damage the power cord when moving the machine away from the wall.
- D. If the power cord is damaged or the plug is worn, discontinue use to avoid danger. Replacement must be done by professionals such as the manufacturer or maintenance department.




Unplug the power cord when cleaning, repairing, or replacing machine parts to prevent electric shock.



Dismantling or modifying the machine is strictly forbidden. Maintenance must be carried out by professionals.




To retrieve items, push the door of the pickup slot with one hand while using the other to pick up the goods from the box. The pick-up door is heavy, so be cautious not to pinch your hands. Children should only use the machine with the assistance of an adult.



VENDING MACHINE COMPONENTS FUNCTIONS INTRODUCTION

- Cargo lane: The tray is divided by a partition, and the passage for goods can be a spring or a crawler mechanism.
- Main board: A core component that controls the operation of the vending machine.
- Cash slot: Used for inserting cash when consumers want to purchase goods or for prefilling cash. Cash must be inserted individually and in a single tile for proper recognition.
- Coin slot: Used for inserting coins when consumers want to purchase goods or for prefilling coins. Coins must be inserted one by one.
- Cash machine: Receives, recognizes, stores, and dispenses cash. It can also have the optional function of prefilling change.
- Coin machine: Receives, recognizes, stores, and dispenses coins.
- Refrigeration and heating system: Optional system for cooling or heating goods.
- 5-inch display screen: Displays information to users.
- Metal keyboard: Used for product selection and menu operation input.
- Machine lock: Locks the machine door and container to prevent loss of goods.
- Coin return button: Used to return inserted coins or in case of a coin jam.
- Change slot: The window where users receive change or coins that were not recognized by the coin return mechanism.
- Pickup slot: The area where users retrieve purchased items.
- Power cord: Used to connect the vending machine to an external power supply. Ensure it is plugged into a reliable grounded socket.
- POS Device: Used for credit card transactions.
- Cargo lane number/price tag: Used to display cargo lane numbers and price information, making it easier for users to make purchases.










The heartbeat interval is a mechanism to keep online, set to 20 second. The machine shall send an instruction to the server every 20 seconds to synchronize the server online status. The longer the heartbeat interval is set, the more the machine saves traffic, but the longer the state synchronization interval is, the shorter the heartbeat interval is, the real-time update of the machine's status is, but the more traffic is consumed. It is recommended that the heartbeat interval be set a little shorter where the network signal is poor.

Cleaning of vending machines


- 1. When the machine is dusty, wipe it with a dry cloth.
- 2. If the dirt is serious, wipe it with cloth dampened with water or diluted neutral detergent solution.
- 3. Do not use organic solvent or acid or alkaline liquid to clean, otherwise the panel may be cracked.
- 4. When removing the dirt from the vending machine, do not use chemical solvents such as paint solvents and banana water to avoid accidents.
- 5. The evaporator and condenser should be cleaned regularly with water every month. If necessary, rinse with water (refer to sticker of "Refrigerator Cleaning Guide" on the fuselage for details).
- 6. Open the machine door, undo the power plug, remove the bezel or the cargo bucket, and clean the dust with a non-metallic brush along the gap of the radiator.

Test Leakage Protection Switch

- 1. Press the test switch of the power plug. When the power indicator is off and the machine is powered off,it must be tested once a month.
- 2. If it is normal after the test, press the plug switch to turn on the power after 3 minutes.


3. Rotate the sealing cover clockwise. When the sealing cover can on longer be rotated, the sealing cover can be removed outward.



4. Clean up the dust from top to bottom with a soft brush (not a metal brush) along the gap of radiator.



5. After cleaning, fasten both sides of the sealing cover to the notch, rotate half circle counterclockwise and fix the sealing cover.



Note: When cleaning evaporator, please pay attention to not let the temperature probe touch the radiator and inner metal part of the evaporator. It should be fixed on the watercontaining plate to avoid affecting the cold storage temperature.



Unscrew the spring on the right side of the cargo lane to be merged, disassemble the middle baffle screw of the cargo lane to be merged (the plastic baffle can be pushed directly inward and removed) and remove the baffle. Note: the baffle fixed by rivets does not support the merged cargo lane.



3. Disassemble the right spring and replace it with the right-handed spring. Remove the price tag of the right cargo lane and use the price tag of the left lane (for example, after the merger of 141 lane and 142 lane, the merged lane is 141).




4. Pull out the plug of the motor wire on the right side of the cargo lane and insert it into another jack. Connect the merged tray to the terminal, arrange and bind the wiring harness and push it into the main cabinet. At the same time, set the corresponding lane into the merged lane in the software menu.

ADJUSTMENT OF LAYER HEIGHT

1. Cut the tie-up cable, pull out the tray and disconnect the terminal behind the tray.



2. Use screwdriver to loosen and remove the screws of the cargo lane slide rail. Adjust the slide rail to the appropriate height and fix it with screws (Note: the height of the slide rail on both sides must be the same).




3. Connect the tray terminals, tidy up and bind the lane wiring harness, and push the lane into the main cabinet.


Installation Of Blocking Device

Installation of the blocking device is to prevent higher products from dumping forward, and the upper end of item is against the glass when delivery, which causes the spring to be unable to push the goods out of the lane.



Installation Of Spring Front End

The front end of the spring is used for some cargo lanes placing thinner goods when the goods can not be pushed out at one time.
